

Fewer people visiting the pub

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TGI data shows that the number of people who drink in pubs has fallen despite increasing fears about binge drinking and 24-hour opening.

Researchers for the TGI survey found in 1987, 17% of adults went out to drink more than once a week compared with the current 12%, or 5.5 million adults.
