A. Imports of Gold has grown month on month basis by 8.35%.

Total value of imports in May 2014 was 2444.38 M, compared to April 2014, there is an increase of 188.36 M in May 2014, growth rate in percentage terms is 8.35%, the major destination countries were Switzerland, United arab Emirates, South africa, United States and australia and major Indian ports were Delhi Air, Calcutta Air, Ahmedabad Air, Bangalore Air and Bombay Air.

B. Imports of Silver has fallen month on month basis by -17.58%.

Total value of imports in May 2014 was 385.46 M, compared to April 2014, there is a decrease of -82.2 M in May 2014, growth rate in percentage terms is -17.58%, the major destination countries were China, Russia, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Germany and major Indian ports were Delhi Air, Ahmedabad ICD, Madras Sea, Ahmedabad Air and Calcutta Air.

C. Imports of Ferrous Waste and Scrap or Remelting Scrap Ingots of Iron or Steel has grown month on month basis by 5.14%.

Total value of imports in May 2014 was 256.96 M, compared to April 2014, there is an increase of 12.56 M in May 2014, growth rate in percentage terms is 5.14%, the major destination countries were South africa, United arab Emirates, United Kingdom, australia and Malaysia and major Indian ports were JNPT, Madras Sea, Ludhiana ICD, Vizag Sea and Mundra.

D. Imports of Aluminium Waste and Scrap has grown month on month basis by 9.25%.

Total value of imports in May 2014 was 130.36 M, compared to April 2014, there is an increase of 11.04 M in May 2014, growth rate in percentage terms is 9.25%, the major destination countries were United arab Emirates, Saudi arabia, United Kingdom, United States and Netherlands and major Indian ports were JNPT, Ahmedabad ICD, Madras Sea, Dadri-ACPL CFS and Dadri-STTPL CFS.
